Eliminating Keys Increases Security and Can Give You Complete Control

Most people, when attempting to secure a property are primarily concerned with controlling unauthorized access or break-ins. But in order to be in complete control, you also need to control authorized access.

The Best Security is Simple Security
Some people fear that maintaining complete control will involve cumbersome technology and procedures which will adversely impact the daily operations of the facility. In fact, the simpler the controls, the more they will be used, the less they will be circumvented, the greater the security. A properly constructed set of controls, will provide higher security and reduce the likeliness of compromise by amateurs, professionals and insiders.

Non-Reporting & Reporting Systems
There are two major categories of access systems, Non-Reporting and Reporting. Non-Reporting systems will allow you to eliminate keys and easily change the access code to control the access of the facility. Reporting systems also report the use by user, by security point (door), by time and by date. This provides an audit trail of accesses and attempts.

Non-Reporting Systems

Many of these systems are simple to install and require little or no wiring while providing economic security.

Most Non-Reporting systems allow you to issue a limited number of access codes. Often everyone will use the same access code.

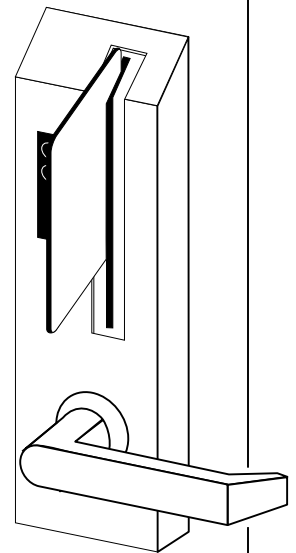
Reporting Systems

With reporting systems, each user is issued their own pin number or card. This allows you to track all of the access information. You can program the system with time windows

and link together several units to create a virtual masterkey system.
