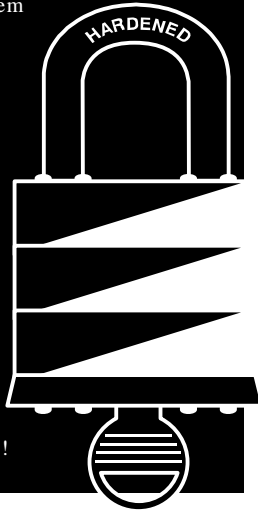


## Just Buy'em By the Case (It'll Simplify Your Life.)

### What? You Rarely Open Your Safe!

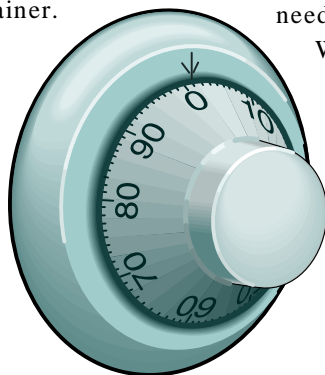
